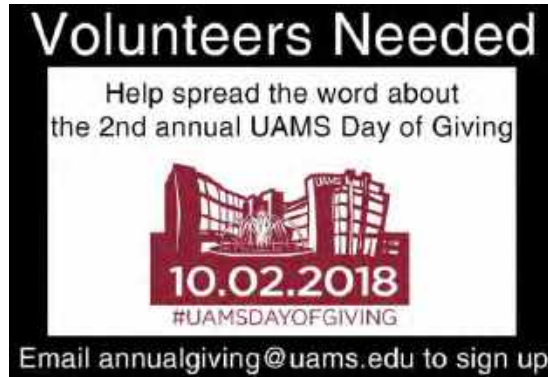
Heroes Against Hunger
